During King David's reign, the tabernacle (the movable tent) that Moses had made was erected at the high place in Gibeon. This tabernacle represented the presence of God among the people.

At one particular time when David sinned, he needed a more immediate and convenient altar, so God sent him to Ornan and told David to build on Ornan's threshing floor. **1 Chronicles 21:26** says, "And David built there an altar to the LORD, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings, and called on the LORD; and He answered him from heaven by fire on the altar of burnt offering."

Thanks to Jesus, the sacrificial system is out, the need to go through Levitical priests to get to God is out, and the need to stand before a particular altar whenever you pray is out. However, even though all those things are no more, the spirit of each part of David's worship is still necessary today.

KEY TEXT Pro. 24:16, "For a just man falleth seven times, and riseth up again: but the wicked shall fall into mischief."


POWER THOUGHT

POWER THOUGHT

...if 'it' is not excellent, it is not good enough for our God.

very Christian has a high calling— the call to excellence.It takes a special measure of dedication to be excellent, especially for the Christian life. Excellence in Christianity does not happen by accident. It requires commitment and strong motivation. Paul said, "I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus" (Phil. 3:14 RSV).

Paul was a man dedicated to excellence as a Christian. He did not believe in careless commitments. His goals were high, his standards were high and his purpose in life was to be the very best person in Christ Jesus that he could be. In the third chapter of Philippians, he shares his reasons for reaching for excellence. First, he said, *"I press on…because Christ Jesus has made me His own"*(vs. 12). The apostle chose excellence as a way of life! Heunderstood that if 'it' is not excellent, it is not good enough for our God. Jesus Christ has chosen you and therefore you can't live a mediocre life; *"You did not choose Me, but I chose you …that you should go and bear fruit …"* (Jn. 15:16). Reaching out for excellence demands that you are constantly and consistently growing. With each passing day, it becomes difficult to be excellent in this falling world, but remember that the Christian who thinks that he has arrived is only stagnated.

While the spark of excellence is undeniably resident within you, you must fan its embers to flame through a g e n u i n e c o m m i t m e n t a n d determination to be the best at all times. Don't live in mediocrity, strive for excellence and stand out!


POWER Service adds value to people.

esus was the greatest leader of all time. The record of His life and ministry in the Bible still intrigues every reader till this day. It's fascinating how Jesus transformed twelve ordinary and unlikely people into the first generation of leaders of a movement that continues to affect the course of world history 2,000 years later. He gives a practical and effective leadership model for all organizations, for all people, for all situations.

Jesus' views on leadership are conspicuously out of step with the conventional wisdom of our age. According to Christ, then, the truest kind of leadership demands service, sacrifice, and selflessness. A proud and self-promoting person is not a good leader by Christ's standard. Leaders who look to Christ as their Leader and their supreme model of leadership will have servants' hearts. They will exemplify sacrifice. **Matt. 20:27-28**, "And whosoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant: Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many."Service adds value to people. When leaders serve, they add value to the people who receive their service. This value might be as simple as feeling worthwhile or special. It could be that the value is a resource we put in people's hands or a word of

encouragement we speak to them. Whatever it is, people always receive something and feel better about themselves because of their leader.

Cultivate the good habit of adding value to everyone you meet; try to add something to their lives rather than take away. Seek to replenish and resource them to live the higher life God has called them to.



THE FULFILLING LIFE


KEY TEXT Acts 13:36, "For David, after he had served the purpose of God in his own generation, fell asleep and was laid with his fathers..."

POWER THOUGHT You can't do anything about the length of your life, but you can do something about its width and depth.

The life well-lived is the life that learns to embrace the law of the Creator. We can only find happiness, meaning, and contentment when we become what we are created to become. The best of life is to be found not in the accumulation of riches or in achieving fame. Such aspirations may lead to success by worldly standards, but real fulfillment comes from a life well spent.

One distinctive command of the Bible is that the greatest joy is found in loving God with all your heart and treating others with compassion and charity (Mk. 12:30-31). American humorist Evan Esar wrote, "You can't do anything about the length of your life, but you can do something about its width and depth." It is not what is etched upon a tombstone that is remembered most, but rather what is carved upon the hearts of others. Spend your life on giving out value and watch yourself enjoy fulfilment.

KEY TEXT Matt. 25:15, "And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey."


POWER THOUGHT


POWER No excuse is big enough to disqualify you THOUGHT

A nyone who loves Jesus, the Church, and loves the lost would want to make his or her life count for Christ. But sometimes we can become so full of knowledge, about the needs and opportunities out there, that we don't know where to begin!

From **Matt. 35-38**, there are four stepsthat will guide you in making a revolutionary impact for Christ.

- SEE AS JESUS SAW When Jesus looked at the crowds, He didn't just see a clamouring group of people. He looked beyond the surface and realized they were spiritually depressed and downcast. When you look out at the world today your neighborhood, your community, your country what do you see?


POWER Maintaining focus is a battle you have to fight daily.

hese are the last days, and Satan knows his time is up, so he is on the prowl, causing many more calamities (**Rev. 12:12**). His agenda is to kill, steal and destroy (**Jn. 10:10**) and one of his subtle weapons in this present time is distraction. Somehow, he finds a way to disguise a distraction and makes his victims get lost without their knowledge. This kind of vice is what I call 'Excusable Distraction'.

Excusable distraction is a distraction that sounds logical and acceptable; something that doesn't seem wrong at first but gradually works its way into your life and becomes a barrier to destiny momentum. As Christians, maintaining focus is a battle you have to fight daily because everything around you is seeking your attention. You can imagine how a man, who happens to be a believer striving and working hard to excel, quickly loses his drive when he is told that he is being manipulated by a witch. Then he starts fighting the witch and forgets to work on how to be great. This may not have looked like a distraction, but it has slowed down his destiny momentum.


POWER THOUGHT


POWER THOUGHT Spirit-driven people live purpose-driven lives.

veryone's life is driven by something. Drive means to guide, to control or to direct. It can mean guiding and controlling something or directing it to the appropriate place at that moment. There are many circumstances, values, emotions that can drive one's life.

What is the driving force in your life? Some people are driven by a problem. They go to where ordinarily they would not have gone if things were normal. Others are driven by pressure or deadlines. There are people who are driven by painful memories or haunting fear or unconscious belief. There is another set driven by fear. These people cannot venture out. They fear further failure because they have failed before. Fear-driven people miss great opportunities. They play safe, avoiding risks. 
POWER THOUGHT What's the use of a light that cannot give light?


God is not the author of your troubles

He wasn't a valiant warrior-king who was always full of faith and endowed with a disproportionate dose of fiery courage. No, he was a regular guy. He did what you and any of us would have done—he panicked. But what set Jehoshaphat apart was that even when he was fearful, the very first thing he did was to "set himself to seek the Lord" **(2 Chron. 20:3)**. That is something you need to learn to do as well. When you are feeling overwhelmed by your circumstances, that is the time you need to seek

the Lord. God is not the author of your troubles. He is the author and finisher of your faith, victory and success.

God doesn't condemn you when you are afraid. But when you receive a negative medical report or some bad news about your family or business, set yourself to seek the Lord. Jesus is your answer! His perfect love for you will cast out all fear.


POWER TAPPing into the core essence of who you are makes you an asset.

POWER THOUGHT


Grace produces true holiness.


POWER The smallest crowd you will ever lead is you.


Passion doesn't hide.


Good is the enemy of the best





We tend to look to

people and material things to satisfy our earthly desires instead of looking to the Lord!

Do you need a touch from the Lord today? Let's abandon the ways we've been reaching out to the world for strength -- and determine to reach out to the Lord in faith and believe!

POWER THOUGHT


In the end, it's not the years in your life that count, it's the life in your years

in Jesus' name.







