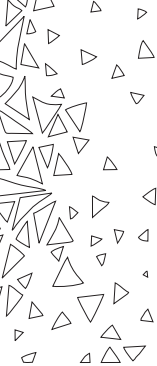

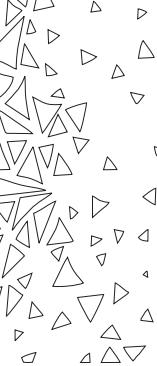
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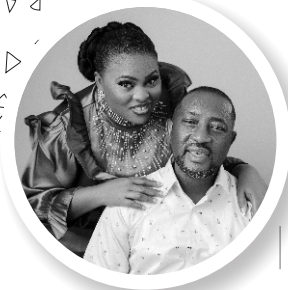

▶ INTRODUCTION

"And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there prayed."

Mark 1:35

During King David's reign, the tabernacle (the movable tent) that Moses had made was erected at the high place in Gibeon. This tabernacle represented the presence of God among the people.

At one particular time when David sinned, he needed a more immediate and convenient altar, so God sent him to Ornan and told David to build on Ornan's threshing floor. **1 Chronicles 21:26** says, "*And David built there an altar to the LORD, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings, and called on the LORD; and He answered him from heaven by fire on the altar of burnt offering.*"

Thanks to Jesus, the sacrificial system is out, the need to go through Levitical priests to get to God is out, and the need to stand before a particular altar whenever you pray is out. However, even though all those things are no more, the spirit of each part of David's worship is still necessary today.

You see, your body is now the temple. **1st Corinthians 6:19** says, "*Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit...?*"

It is your responsibility to build an altar to the Lord in your heart, maintain it, and visit it frequently! Receive grace!

BE THE EXTENSION OF GOD'S LOVE (I)

KEY TEXT

Matthew 5:13 "Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? It is henceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out and be trodden under foot of men."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: The Bible calls us the salt of the earth. Just as salt enhances the taste of food, we are expected to add value to the world around us. This means that as a Christian, God expects you to enhance or add value wherever you find yourself.

One powerful way we can add value to our world is by being generous. In Acts 9:36-41, we can see the reward of generosity in the life of Dorcas. Dorcas did kind things for others and helped the poor. But unfortunately, she fell ill one day and died, and was prepared for burial. But when the Believers heard that Apostle Peter was nearby at Lydda, they sent a message pleading with him to come quickly. When Peter arrived, the widows in great sorrow, showed Peter the clothes Dorcas had made for them—a testament to a life poured out for others. Then Peter ministered to Dorcas and she came back to life. The news of Dorcas' restoration spread through the whole town, bringing many to salvation.

APPLICATION: Your value is not determined by your valuables, but by how much value you place on people. Strive to be an extension of God's love in the lives of others. God honors those who place value on people. When you honor God through generosity, God goes ahead of you to fight your battles.



Father, cause the light of Your goodwill to shine through me.

John 1 – 2

BE THE EXTENSION OF GOD'S LOVE (2)

KEY
TEXT

Psalms 117:2 "For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the truth of the Lord endureth for ever. Praise ye the Lord."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: If the merciful kindness of God towards us is great, we have no excuse to be anything less. God proved His love for us by giving up His Dear Son Jesus as a sacrifice for our redemption. Because of what Jesus has done for us, we are expected to reciprocate same in the lives of others through generosity. But quite unfortunately, a lot of us still struggle with being generous for reasons such as selfishness, unavailability of funds, and the fear of being misinterpreted.

This notwithstanding, generosity remains one of the most powerful avenues through which we can showcase the Gospel. It is not just an act—it is a reflection of the very heart of God. When we choose to give, even from our place of lack, heaven takes notice and grace multiplies. Each generous act becomes a spark that lights up dark places, revealing the beauty of God's compassion to a watching world. Generosity models godliness, authenticates God's love, opens hard hearts, judges wickedness, and attracts a divine reward. Make up your mind today to be an extension of God's love through generosity.

John 3 – 4

GIVE SACRIFICIALLY

KEY
TEXT

Luke 21:4 "For all these have of their abundance cast in unto the offerings of God: but she of her penury hath cast in all the living she had."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: People sense the love of Christ when we extend kindness to them—and even more profoundly, when we give sacrificially. The truth is, we do not have to wait until we have much before we give. In fact, God is most delighted and glorified when we give out of the little we have, for it reveals trust that transcends circumstance. One of the most outstanding characters in the Bible who exemplified this truth is the widow of Zarephath, who gave virtually out of nothing.

The brook where Elijah was regularly fed by the raven dried up because a fierce famine had ravaged the land. For the purpose of sustaining Elijah, God directed a widow in Zarephath—someone who seemed least capable—to provide food for Elijah. When Elijah got to her, she was gathering sticks to prepare her last meal before she and her son would die. But Elijah said, *"Don't be afraid. Go home and do as you have said. But first, make a small loaf of bread for me with what you have and bring it to me."* That moment became a divine test of faith—a call to trust God beyond reason and to give when giving made no sense. Her obedience unlocked heaven's provision, reminding us that when we release what's in our hands, God releases what's in His.

APPLICATION: Most times, the greatest blessings come from our sacrificial acts of generosity. After she made that sacrifice, there was constant supply of food for her, her family and Elijah. Sometimes, when we do not have enough, that is usually the best time to give because the ways of God are not the ways of man.



Father, as You gave Your only begotten Son, I vow to give my best.



Make a decision today to make a sacrifice for someone in need.



John 5 – 6

GIVE BY FAITH

KEY
TEXT

1 Kings 17:15 (NIV) *"She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family."*

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Faith does not move mountains: It is our faith-actions that move mountains. When Elijah asked the widow of Zarephath to prepare a meal and bring it to him, she heard from the mouth of the Prophet, *"This is what the Lord, the God of Israel says: The jar of flour will not be used up, and the jug of oil will not run dry until the day the Lord sends rain to the land."* She heard, she believed and she went a step further to act on her belief. Her obedience turned scarcity into abundance and despair into divine visitation. What seemed like a small act of surrender became the bridge between her desperation and her miracle.

Too many people struggle with giving their best or like in this case, their last, because they feel they cannot do without what they have been instructed to release. If the widow of Zarephath had refused to give Elijah her last meal, her satisfaction would not have lasted beyond that same day. Sometimes, God will ask you to give out of your lack—in faith—because He has already reserved a reward for you. The Lord who commands you to give, is able to supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

APPLICATION: Why does God require us to give? To test our stewardship, to test our faith in Him, to open doors of divine supplies for us, and to reveal His faithfulness to others through us.



Lord Jesus, give me the grace to trust You and to walk in complete obedience to You.



If you once flouted a divine instruction in the past to give, ask the Lord for mercy today.



John 7 – 8

SEE IT AS GOD SEES IT

COVENANT DAY OF FASTING AND PRAYER

KEY TEXT

Hebrews 11:1 "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: God's ways are not the ways of man. Most times, we do not enjoy the best of God because we do not see or perceive life from God's perspective. How does a jar of flour or a jug of oil never run dry? To the carnally-minded, that would be outrightly impossible. Men who see it as God sees it, are the ones who encounter the divine manifestations of God. The supernatural is not unlocked by logic but by trust; when reason ends, revelation begins. Every act of obedience, no matter how small, becomes a doorway through which heaven touches earth. There are levels of God-encounters you may never experience until you learn to act in obedience and trust God foolishly.

PRAYER POINTS:

1. Father, I thank You for the blessing of spiritual insight. By Your grace, I will not be taken unawares by life's negative situations.
2. Father, through me, let Your presence provoke destiny ease and speed in the lives of others. Help me to be a giver of life to the helpless and downtrodden.
3. O God, help me to raise those in need especially in this season of kindness. Use me as a proof of Your faithfulness.
4. I reject every voice of darkness trying to influence my thinking. I command my mind and spirit to be set free from the influences of selfishness and greed.
5. Lord Jesus, let my life be a reflection of Your goodness. Every force of hell trying to truncate my destiny through stubbornness, I command you to catch fire now!
6. As iron sharpeneth iron, I will not determine anyone's destiny for bad, and no one will determine mine for evil. As I give generously, let my reward be made manifest at destiny's appointed time.
7. Lord, I declare that I and the people You have positioned me to help, our journey shall be forward only! Our lives will not run in cycles of shame, smallness and poverty.
8. I declare that Gateway International Church is increasing on every side. We are bursting forth beyond boundaries and limitations with unrelenting momentum.

DAILY BIBLE
READING

John 9 – 10

FOLLOW OBEDIENTLY

KEY
TEXT

1Thessalonians 5:11 (NIV) "Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Sometimes, God will ask you to surrender something very precious—not to take from you, but to lift you, and often, to lift someone else through you. His requests may not always make sense, yet they are always rooted in His purpose. Many believers never experience divine lifting because they stop at reasoning instead of obeying. Divine instructions carry divine rewards, but only for those who obey completely. I have also discovered that many prefer to give in ways that draw human praise, rather than in obedience that glorifies God. But true giving is not about recognition—it's about surrender. When you give from a place of love and trust, heaven records it as worship, and God responds with favor beyond measure.

In the case of the widow of Zarephath, if she had not been spiritually sensitive, she and her son would have perished in the famine. Nothing extraordinary would have come from her refusal—only another tale of lack and despair. The worst that might have happened was a delay in Elijah's provision, but it would have cost her everything. Her obedience became the turning point, the moment heaven intervened in her story. When she placed God first, lack gave way to abundance, and sorrow was replaced with sustenance. Thankfully, she obeyed—and through that obedience, she encountered the faithfulness of God.

APPLICATION: Many times, when God wants to lift you, He lays it in your heart to help someone in need. That burden in your spirit to help an orphan or widow through very challenging times, could be God trying to sensitize you to alleviate someone's suffering. God has blessed you because He wants to use you to bless others, and in return, bless you. Follow obediently!



Holy Spirit, lead me in the direction You want me to follow in course of helping the needy.



Ask the Holy Spirit for clarity and heed accordingly.



John 11 – 12

COMMIT TOTALLY (I)

KEY
TEXT

Matthew 16:24 "Then Jesus said unto His disciples, 'If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.'"

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: The biggest challenge of commitment is that it defies excuses and objections. When we choose to be truly committed to something, we must come to a place of no retreat and no withdrawal—standing firm regardless of the outcome. We are called to be unwaveringly committed to kingdom building through generosity. When God instructs us to give, we must walk faithfully in obedience—not merely because we seek His blessings, but because we long to be channels through which the world encounters His mercy and lovingkindness. True commitment is tested in seasons of silence, when obedience feels costly and unseen. Yet it is in those hidden moments that God measures the depth of our devotion and strengthens the roots of our faith.

In this light, commitment means offering yourself wholly to the cause of God's Kingdom—whether you give out of plenty or from your lack, whether you are celebrated or forgotten, whether the blessings come quickly or seem delayed. Heaven takes note of the one who stays faithful when results seem distant, for such hearts become vessels through which God displays His enduring love. The question then is this: Can God count on you to remain an expression of His lovingkindness, even when the outcome is not what you expected?

APPLICATION: There are several reasons we must give committedly: People sense the love of Christ in us when we give committedly. This wakes up the good in them to do the same. When we give committedly, it proves our faith in God. It also solves the problems that many prayers have been offered for. And lastly, it markets the Gospel we preach.



Father, use me as Your instrument of grace to draw men to You.



Begin to see yourself as an instrument of God's lovingkindness.



John 13 – 15

COMMIT TOTALLY (2)

KEY TEXT

Ecclesiastes 11:1-2 "Cast thy bread upon the waters: for thou shall find it after many days. Give a portion to seven, and also to eight; for thou knowest not what evil shall be on the earth."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Commitment is being totally sold out to a cause, regardless of external opinions, consequences, or personal discomfort. True commitment is not measured merely by involvement or diligence—it demands complete surrender. In fact, until you are wholly given to a cause you are willing to die for, you cannot truly claim to be committed. Commitment is the fire that refines conviction and separates the casual from the consecrated. It is the silent declaration that God's purpose matters more than your comfort.

Many people begin with passion but fall into compromise when the trials that test commitment arise. If you are committed to kingdom building through giving, there will be times when that commitment leads you into seasons of dryness and delay. But remember—such seasons are not denials, only divine processes that prepare the ground for abundance. Every test of endurance in your commitment is a seed that guarantees a harvest in due time. God often hides His greatest rewards behind seasons that seem empty, to prove the faithfulness of those who remain steadfast. Sadly, many lives and destinies remain trapped because the men and women God entrusted with the grace to relieve others have not stayed faithful to that call. May we never be found holding back what God intends to release through us.

APPLICATION: God wants you to become a channel of lifting, healing and restoration through generosity. So, go out for God a hundred percent. Your determination to take a stand for the cause of helping the needy, is the key to someone's fulfillment and yours. Refire your commitment. Trust the Lord for strength and wisdom.



PRAYER

I receive the grace to stand out in my commitment to kingdom building through generosity.



ACTION POINT

Ask the Lord, what He wants you to do.



DAILY BIBLE READING:

John 16 – 17

A BIGGER HARVEST

KEY
TEXT

Matthew 16:25 "For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: God's future plans for us far outweigh anything we could ever envision for ourselves. His thoughts toward us are higher, His intentions deeper, and His timing perfect. The reality of the future we desire is often shaped by the sacrifices we make for the sake of others. When God calls for a sacrifice on behalf of an individual, family, or community, it is never to diminish you—it is a divine setup for your elevation. Every act of obedience plants a seed in the soil of destiny, and God never forgets the labor of a willing heart. What feels like loss today often becomes the very path that leads to tomorrow's abundance.

So, the question remains: how desperate are you for a bigger harvest? Choose to walk in willingness, commitment, and obedience—because behind every divine instruction lies an opportunity for promotion, and behind every sacrifice, a door to greater glory.

When God makes a demand from you: -

John 18 – 19

MAKE A DIFFERENCE I

KEY TEXT

Proverbs 24:12a (NLT) "Don't excuse yourself by saying 'Look, we didn't know.' For God understands all hearts and he sees you."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Quite a number of people are tempted not to give because they consider themselves too unworthy or insignificant to make a meaningful contribution. We have been called to make a difference in our world through generosity, irrespective of our social or financial status. There is no one who has nothing to give, because God has placed within each of us a seed meant to bless others. What matters is not the size of the gift, but the sincerity of the heart behind it. When you give from a place of faith and love, heaven multiplies even the smallest offering into something extraordinary.

Intentional giving is activated by three key factors: conviction, intentionality, and creativity. Conviction is the stage where you experience a mental and spiritual shift; you begin to see yourself as God's vessel of blessing, even in seasons of personal need. Intentionality is where you act on that conviction, choosing to look inward and discover what you can offer. And creativity is the stage where you strive to create something out of what seems like nothing—for example, rendering a free service, volunteering your time, or using your skills to lift another. Generosity is not about abundance; it is about alignment; allowing God to use what's in your hand to touch a heart and reveal His love.

APPLICATION: You don't need too much to make a difference. If you are not capable of giving tangible things, you can always render a service. No matter how bad your situation is, you can make impact for Jesus. There is a world of possibilities waiting to be explored through acts of kindness. Receive grace to market Jesus this season!



Father, by Your Spirit, guide me to the people who need what You have empowered me to give.



Look within: What can you give or do? You are not empty-handed!



John 20 – 21

MAKE A DIFFERENCE (2)

KEY TEXT

John 6:9 (NLT) "There's a young boy here with five barley loaves and two fish, But what good is that with this huge crowd?"

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Renowned Afro-American gospel artiste, Alvin Slaughter's song *El-Shaddai*, often brings to mind, the story of the little boy and his five barley loaves of bread and two fish in John 6. The chorus of that song goes thus, *"And He'll say, What's that you have in your hands? I can use it, if you're willing to lose it. Take the little you have and make it grand. I am El-Shaddai and I'll more than supply your need."*

Centuries after that profound encounter, this little lad is still remembered for the huge difference he made when he offered his five loaves of bread and two fish, in a remote place where there was no possibility of finding food for the mammoth crowd that gathered to listen to Jesus. The Bible says that afterwards, twelve baskets of left-over bread and fish were gathered. What the little boy surrendered was so little, yet it made such a huge difference.

APPLICATION: Jesus can make a difference through you. This is why He's asking you today, *"What's that you have in your hands? I can use it, if you're willing to lose it"* There is something in your hands. If Jesus is in need of it, then it is not too small or too inconsequential to

make a difference. What is important, is that you are willing to 'lose' it.



Oh Lord, help me to surrender what I need to surrender.



If the Lord needs something from you, surrender it no matter how big or little.



Acts 1 – 3

THE MAN GOD TRUSTS

COVENANT DAY OF FASTING AND PRAYER

KEY TEXT

Proverbs 28:13 "For surely there is a hereafter, and your hope will not be cut off."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: If God is making a demand on you, it means He trusts you. Divine demands are not punishment, they are proofs of partnership. There is a weight God will never place on you until He is certain you are mature enough to carry it with grace and faith. When God demanded the sacrifice of Isaac, it was not to break Abraham but to build him; to reveal that his love for God was greater than his love for the promise. Every divine test is a doorway to transformation; every sacrifice reveals the depth of your trust in God. What feels like surrender today often becomes the altar upon which destinies are preserved and futures secured.

When you release what God is demanding, a covenant is established—an unbreakable bond between heaven and earth. And by that covenant, your destiny and posterity are divinely preserved. The question is not whether God can bless you, but whether He can trust you with the kind of obedience that unlocks generational blessings. Elevate yourself to the level of the man or woman God can trust.

PRAYER POINTS:

1. Father, I thank You for the privilege to be trusted by You, and for the grace to walk in the paths You have chosen for me.
2. Lord, I want to be a man/woman You can trust. Help me to walk in the path that would birth the glorious destiny that You have for me.
3. I declare that misplaced priorities and foolish activities will never be found in my life again. I am walking in faith, strength, wisdom and divine insight.
4. Anything being orchestrated by the enemy to drag me down into the pits of failure, shame, stagnation and confusion, I destroy it by fire! Lord, use me in the dimensions of grace You so desire.
5. I receive commanded skills and ideas that will help me impact my generation positively. I command every dormant potential in my life to come alive! Nothing dies in my hands!
6. By grace, I declare that I am dependable and reliable. I am championing God's divine cause for my life.
7. I tear down the walls of limitation threatening to make me live below destiny's expectation. Thank You Lord for every connection and resource You have given me.
8. Lord, use Gateway International Church as a tool for bringing men and women to the knowledge of Your saving grace through kindness. Help each one to flourish and be planted in this house.

READING:

Acts 4 – 5

HAVE A GOOD HEART

KEY
TEXT

Psalms 41:1 (NLT) "Oh the joy of those who are kind to the poor! The Lord rescues them when they are in trouble."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Quite a number of people shy away from receiving help because sometimes, they are made to feel inadequate by reason of their less-privileged status. The privilege to help the needy should not be a reason to treat them with disrespect which often results in feelings of despair and a sense of abandonment. No true Believer treats a less-privileged person in a derogatory manner.

People rather, honor those who place value on them. When we show love and exercise faith in the needy, they naturally begin to grow faith in themselves. If we must touch lives, we need to be intentional when relating with the needy, by culturing and displaying a healthy attitude. So, the question is, how would you rate yourself in your relationships with the needy? The questions below, will help ascertain if there is need to work on your attitude.

APPLICATION: Do you treat the needy with disrespect? Are you quick to judge and relegate them to the background? How do you treat those who cannot fight back? How do you react when no reward is promised or guaranteed? And how do you treat those who helped you to rise in life?Have a good heart. You will harvest the seeds you have sown; good or bad.



O God, give me a heart of humility and compassion.



Decide that you are going to show love and respect to the less-privileged from today.



Acts 6 – 7

GO AFTER GOD'S HEART

KEY TEXT

Acts 13:22 "And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king: to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: You are close and committed to God as you choose to be. Being committed to God does not come by chance but by intentionality. King David made numerous mistakes during his reign as king, but God called him a man after His heart because David was intentional about his relationship with God.

Jesus' relationship with the Father is a model for the kind of relationship we need to develop with God. Jesus was intentional in the sense that He was devoted to pleasing the Father. We need to come to a point where we are intentional about pleasing the Lord, especially in the area of giving. Until you are committed to pleasing the Lord in your giving, you cannot say you are a man or woman after God's heart. True friendship with the Father, is not passive but active. It goes beyond mere confession.

APPLICATION: How can you develop yourself into being a man or woman after God's heart? Desire friendship with God more than anything else, learn to tarry in God's presence, listen to the Holy Spirit, walk in obedience and commitment through faith, and place value on what God values.

Acts 8 – 9

LET IT FIT PERFECTLY

KEY
TEXT

1Samuel 15:22a (NLT) "But Samuel replied, 'What is more pleasing to the Lord: your burnt offerings and sacrifices or your obedience to his voice?'"

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: As humans, we naturally tend to view life through the lens of the physical, but God relates with us from the realm of the supernatural. While our vision is limited to what is visible, God's perception penetrates beyond what the eyes can see. He sees and knows things about us far deeper than we could ever comprehend. Where we see the surface, God sees the story; where we perceive limitation, He sees purpose in the making. The more we align our sight with His, the more clearly we begin to walk in the flow of His divine wisdom.

When it comes to giving, many of us are prone to making decisions based solely on what we see or hear. Yet there are moments when God calls us to act differently; to give, help, or speak beyond logic and convenience. For this reason, every child of God must grow to operate at a level of discernment that engages the intellect, the emotions, and the spirit. Intellectual capacity enables us to reason and recognize the obvious needs of others. Emotional intelligence helps us perceive the hidden cries of the heart. And spiritual intelligence empowers us to understand what God is saying concerning a particular person or situation. True generosity flows not just from what we know, but from what we discern in the secret place of communion with God.

APPLICATION: When giving, it is also important you ask yourself this important question; 'What does God want for this person?' Elijah heard the voice of God and the Widow of Zarephath discerned. By God's leading, they met each other's need, and both were blessed in the end. It was more like a round peg fitting into a round hole. And guess what! It fit perfectly. Give also, in accordance with divine instruction and measure.

Acts 10 – 11

LOVE LIKE JESUS (I)

KEY
TEXT

Ephesians 5:2 "And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Love is the bedrock of everything we hope to invest in humanity. It is the foundation upon which every act of kindness, generosity, and compassion must stand. God desires that our lives reflect the depth of our fellowship with Him by walking in obedience to His commandments—one of which is to love our brothers and sisters in Christ unconditionally. Kindness is not limited to meeting physical needs; it also extends to healing the unseen wounds of the heart. There are believers around us whose greatest longing is simply to be loved, accepted, or heard. There are many who do not seek material help, but only a reassuring voice that whispers, "Everything will be alright." To love like Jesus is to notice the unnoticed and to touch lives where words alone cannot reach. Compassion becomes holy when it flows from the heart of God through willing vessels like you.

Suicidal tendencies often stem from deep feelings of hopelessness and isolation. When a person gives up on life, it is usually because they have lost faith in love and humanity. In this season of kindness, make it your mission to reach out intentionally to those who are hurting emotionally and spiritually. A simple act of love can restore faith, rekindle hope, and remind a weary soul that God has not forgotten them. Through you, let someone encounter the comfort of God's heart today. Love like Jesus!

LOVE LIKE JESUS (2)

KEY TEXT

1 John 3:18-19 (NLT) "Dear children, let's not merely say that we love each other; let us show the truth by our actions. Our actions will show that we belong to the truth, so we will be confident when we stand before God."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Apostle John said that if any claims to be living in the light but hates his fellow Believer, such a person is living in darkness, and is also blinded by darkness. John advised Believers to demonstrate godly love among themselves, but quite unfortunately, a lot of Christians are shying away from loving one another genuinely because of past hurts. A lot have covered up their weaknesses and challenges with a die-hard attitude because they do not trust anyone.

Our salvation is God's divine opportunity to bring us into partnership with Him, in order to draw souls to the Kingdom. But if the people of the world, cannot testify of the existence of genuine love among us, how do we minister to them effectively, and how do we convince them that Jesus truly loves them?

APPLICATION: If you have been hurt, God sees your pain. Jesus endured horrendous pain and shame so that you could receive His grace to lay yours down at the foot of the Cross. Do not be like the people of the world who handle their differences and disappointments with pride and hard-heartedness. You cannot

touch the world for Jesus if you are under the influence of destructive emotions. Let us make a choice to be shining examples of true discipleship by loving one another the way Jesus loves us.

Acts 14 – 15

RESIST THE RESISTOR (I)

KEY TEXT

Luke 11:33 "No man, when he hath lighted a candle, putteth it in a secret place, neither under a bushel, but on a candlestick, that they which come in may see the light."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: God's light shines brightest through acts of kindness. It is through our compassion and generosity that the world catches a glimpse of His love. Yet sometimes, in our effort to do good, even well-meaning believers find themselves resisted or misunderstood. Beloved, there are both spiritual resistances and, quite unfortunately, human resistances. The enemy often stirs opposition not because your kindness is weak, but because your obedience threatens the darkness he controls. Every act of love you show is warfare. It is a declaration that light will not bow to darkness.

When God wants to bless a person, He sends another person. And when Satan plots to destroy a life, he also works through people. There are blessings that have been delayed or diverted because of human resistances—through discouragement, slander, envy, and manipulation. No matter how pure your intentions may be, not everyone will celebrate or accept them. But the truth remains unshaken: God still chooses to work through human vessels. So, keep shining. Even when resisted, your kindness becomes a weapon, and your perseverance becomes proof that light will always prevail over darkness.

APPLICATION: If you are a vessel chosen by God to bring life, healing and peace to the down-trodden, keep doing what the Lord has laid in your heart without fear of resistance or opposition. Resist human resistors through prayer, courage, and if necessary, discretion. God has made you a light to the nations. So, do not allow anyone quench your light.

Acts 16 – 17

RESIST THE RESISTOR (2)

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Men are ladders and lifters of men. God cannot help a man without the assistance of other men. There are people who are almost absolutely without help. No one is standing by them or speaking on their behalf. Few persons ever give them any form of assistance. When there is an absence or shortage of help, opportunities pass by, and nothing noble gets done. If God is laying it in your heart to lift others, resist every resistor with everything you've got! Fight to accomplish this divine call! Christianity is a call to progression, not stagnation! Help people to rise out of stagnation.

PRAYER POINTS:

1. Father, I thank You for Your Spirit that lives in me. I receive quick understanding, clarity of thoughts and a discerning heart.
2. Lord, help me to make the right decisions. No more destiny errors! No more wrong decisions!
3. I call forth divine partnerships to help me actualize God's divine plan in the lives of those He has programmed for a lifting through me.
4. No one passing through me will ever experience loss. Everyone that has been assigned to me will encounter lifting and enjoy the blessings of God.
5. Every resistor, the enemy is sponsoring to stop the plans God has for me, I rebuke them and cast them out of my life!
6. No evil personality, no mocker nor friendly enemy would find his way into my life to disturb my assignment.
7. Every demonic strategy orchestrated by hell to bring me or my assignment down, I destroy you now, in the name of Jesus!
8. May Gateway continue to grow from glory to glory! For everyone who comes into Gateway in this season, Father, give them a testimony of divine restoration.

2 Corinthians 8:9 "For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for our sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Through salvation, you became a joint heir with Christ to a divine inheritance. But to enjoy your divine inheritance, you must be connected to the Source who is God through covenant. When you are connected through covenant, you will not lack resources.

Many Christians have exempted themselves from helping the needy because they see themselves instead as the needy. Hear this; poverty is a humiliation of grace and a destiny error that has the capacity to corrupt your life. Abraham's life exemplifies how much we can inherit from the Father through Christ. Abraham became very wealthy to the envy of the Philistines, and because of this, Isaac never suffered the shame of poverty or lack.

APPLICATION: Your beginning may be small, but never throw away the confidence that your future is great. As a seed of Abraham, you are an heir to the Promise. How do you begin to enjoy the covenant blessings of God? Obey covenant requirements and remain committed to them. Strive to walk in divine will and purpose. Work at increasing spiritual capacity, and remain connected to the Father.

Acts 20 – 21

CONNECT TO THE SOURCE (2)

KEY TEXT

Genesis 26:2-3a *"And the Lord appeared unto him, and said, Go not down into Egypt; dwell in the land which I shall tell thee of: sojourn in this land, and I will be with thee; and will bless thee....."*

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: At a certain time, there was a severe famine in the land where Isaac lived. Like any reasonable man, Isaac contemplated leaving for another country in search of better opportunities. But God instructed him to stay, and in simple obedience, Isaac remained—and in that same land of lack, he prospered greatly, just as his father Abraham had. His abundance, however, stirred envy in the hearts of the Philistines. What others called a dry land became Isaac's field of harvest because obedience opened the heavens over him. When God is with you, even the desert becomes fertile ground.

God may not always be visible, but His hand is undeniable. He is ever-present to give you divine advantage, just as He did with Isaac—if only you will follow Him diligently and trust His instructions even when they defy logic. One reason the rich often experience a continuous flow of divine provision is that they seize every opportunity to bless others. In contrast, those who see themselves as poor often withdraw from such opportunities, unknowingly shutting the door to God's abundance. Generosity is the key that keeps the divine supply flowing; when you give from faith, you partner with the same God who turns famine into fruitfulness.

APPLICATION: You are an heir of God, not a destitute. God has neither forsaken nor forgotten you. Divine lifting is triggered by a decision. Decide that you will be a part of what God is doing in this season. Then make intentional efforts at building a quality relationship with God through committed covenant practices. He will direct you in the paths of His will.



PRAYER

From this day, I declare that I am walking in newness of life and purpose.



ACTION POINT

Say this to yourself: 'I will not be poor. I will neither borrow nor beg for bread.'



DAILY BIBLE READING:

Acts 22 – 23

MAKE PROGRESS!

KEY
TEXT

Deuteronomy 2:3 (NLT) "You have been wandering around in this hill country long enough; turn to the north!"

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: When God told Moses and the Israelites that they had tarried long enough around the mountain, He was issuing a divine call to advancement. It was time to move forward—time to leave behind the familiar and step into the fullness of His promise. One reason you may not have made significant progress in your giving or financial growth is because you have lingered too long at a particular level, growing comfortable with mediocrity. God's desire is not for you to settle but to stretch; not to circle the same ground, but to conquer new territories of blessing. Your next level begins the moment you decide to rise in faith and move at His command.

In Deuteronomy 3:24, God made it clear that He had already given the Israelites nations and territories, but to possess them, they had to contend in battle. The promise was theirs, but the process required warfare. If you have been circling the same financial level for too long, it's time to stop celebrating small milestones as if they were your final destination. Begin to press forward in prayer, obedience, and faith—reach out for what heaven has already assigned to you. Stagnation breaks when determination meets divine instruction, and progress comes when you refuse to let fear or comfort hold you back. Until the forces of limitation are confronted and conquered, there can be no lasting advancement.

APPLICATION: How do you contend with the forces behind stagnation? Go to God in intense prayer and fasting: Firstly, confess and repent of any sin that may be the stumbling block to your progress. Secondly, deal with perceived curses. Thirdly, take authority over any human resistance by uprooting them forcefully. And lastly, stir up yourself to go on a journey with God by demanding for grace for greater works.

Acts 24 – 26

YOU WILL NOT DIE SMALL!

KEY
TEXT

Jeremiah 17:7 (NLT) "But blessed are those who trust in the Lord and have made the Lord their hope and confidence."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Many times in life, we feel tempted to abandon our vision because of the adversities that confront us or the prolonged seasons of effort that seem to produce little or no result. When expectations are delayed, discouragement often whispers that our dreams are impossible. But the moment we surrender to that voice, we unknowingly settle in the valley of mediocrity. We begin to justify our stagnation by convincing ourselves that our current state is the best we can ever be. Yet, destiny does not thrive in comfort zones; it flourishes in persistence, faith, and resilience. Every great man or woman of purpose had to fight through moments of silence before glory found expression.

You are not called to blend in; you are called to stand out. You are a trailblazer, a pathfinder, a vessel of divine influence, and a person destined for lasting impact in the Kingdom and in humanity. Refuse to yield to the forces that fuel mediocrity and stagnation. The same God who planted that vision in your heart is faithful to empower you to fulfill it. Hold on—your perseverance will soon speak louder than your pain. God is your source, but men are His channels. Your future is great! You will not die small!

KEY
TEXT*Matthew 11:12 "And from the days of John the Baptist until now, the Kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent taketh it by force."*

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Existence is a matter of chance but greatness comes by choice. Two people can be born at the same level but they do not necessarily end at the same level. One can break out and succeed while the other is left behind, confused and literally unable to forge his way forward.

Les Brown, internationally recognized motivational speaker, was assessed as intellectually uneducable at an early age but his brother had an edge over him. In a desperate move to satisfy a deep-seated hunger for significance, Les Brown made a choice to overcome his mental handicap and eventually became a multimillionaire. Apart from his success in motivational speaking, he is also a life coach who mentors captains of industry and leading government officials in the United States, while his brother has struggled in and out of drug addiction and remained poor. It was not a difference in their backgrounds but an attitude to life that made the difference.

APPLICATION: It takes intentional effort to go from good to great. It is time to refute the deficiencies that have been militating against your glorious destiny, and join the Jesus army of people whose

passion, is to manifest the destiny cry, *"I won't die small!"* As you believe for great things, begin to make moves in the direction of your dream. Decide that you won't die small!

HAVE PASSION FOR YOUR VOCATION

KEY
TEXT

Matthew 3:5 "Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judea, and all the regions round about Jordan."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Jesus described John the Baptist as a burning and shining light. The Bible testifies that the whole city of Jerusalem, Judea and the regions round about, went out to him in spite of the fact that he was in the wilderness.

John was a burning and shining light because he was passionate about his vocation. He knew who he was, what he was called to do, and was passionate about fulfilling it. When John was asked if he was the Messiah or a prophet, John replied, *"No! I am the voice crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord. My assignment is to prepare the way of the Lord and I am willing to give it all it takes."*

APPLICATION: If you must be relevant to yourself, to the Kingdom and to the needy, you must have passion for your vocation. You cannot rise if you are not passionate about what you do. People who have decided that they would not die small, commit themselves passionately to their vocation. Give life what it takes. Stay focused on your goal until you accomplish it. No one makes credible impact in humanity with empty hands.

KEY TEXT

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Many came to the ascension of their next level but failed to get there because they refused to delay certain gratifications. In order to arrive at your dream destination, there are times you will be required to delay some desires through a life of simplicity and careful management of the resources in your hands. When you are pursuing a destiny dream, the only way you can run fast and strong is when you are not carrying unnecessary baggage. Unnecessary baggage will slow you down considerably. So, drop it! If you must go up, it is essential sometimes that you give up.

PRAYER POINTS:

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Concerning John the Baptist, the Bible says that the whole city came to him. In those days, the Jews did not have a clear understanding of John's ministry, but something beyond the ordinary draw them to him—even though he was in the wilderness. The whole city came to him because John trusted God audaciously for the manifestation of the extraordinary. When a man burns for God, the world cannot ignore his light, even the wilderness becomes a platform for impact. The world still listens to voices that burn with heavenly conviction.

Audacious faith is that radical voracious faith that believes God for anything in spite of the evidences telling you that it is not possible. People with audacious faith, believe without a shred of doubt, that God will perform what He has promised. To manifest audacious faith, you must think supernaturally. Supernatural thinking is allowing God program your thinking and living, not your physical circumstances.

APPLICATION: Believe God to take you beyond your natural abilities. Begin from where you are by taking faith risks, investing in new ideas and building new relationships! Dust off on an old dream and begin to pursue it. Gather vessels not a few and expect God to fill them.

Step out of your comfort zone. Through you, God plans to save lives. So, believe against all odds that God's goodness is going to be evident in your life.

Romans 11 – 14

WALK IN DIVINE FAVOUR

KEY
TEXT

1 Samuel 15:16 (NLT) "I will show mercy to anyone I choose, and I will show compassion to anyone I choose."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: Favour is the hand of God that qualifies the unqualified. Covenant favour overturns rejection, ends life's struggles, moves men from dishonor to honor. There is no achievement in life that comes without an element of favour. Everything you are and have is by the favour of God through the help of His Spirit, the intervention of angels and the assistance of men.

There is a mega dimension of favour that every Christian needs to walk smoothly through life, but why do so many Christians struggle with encountering God's favour particularly in mega dimensions? Truth is, ignorantly and spiritually, a lot of Christians without realizing it, actually abuse favour. Even though there are no set criteria to encountering favour, it is important we understand that certain factors can hinder the manifestation of God's favour over our lives.

APPLICATION: Favour is abused when we despise its source, when we assume it is a right and not a privilege, when we develop an arrival and superiority mentality to past helpers, and when we lose our

sense of boundaries in the corridors of favour. Ask the Lord for the wisdom to recognize and esteem favour.

Romans 15 – 16

TAKE ON THE FAVOUR MINDSET

KEY TEXT

Romans 8:30 (NLT) "And having chosen them, he called them to come to him. And having called them, he gave them right standing with himself. And having given them right standing, he gave them his glory."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: If God has called you His own and called you to Himself, let there be a mental shift in you, that will shift you from a labour-mindset to a favour-mindset. Subconsciously, many Christians rule out favour because they do not have a favour-mindset. They believe they must labour or go through some discomfort before they can be qualified enough to enjoy divine favour.

It should interest you to know that the mindset of a man determines just how much favour he can enjoy. No matter where you are coming from, and no matter what you did in the past, mercy covers your past, but favour guarantees your tomorrow. So, do not be afraid to believe for God's best concerning you.

APPLICATION: How do you trigger a favour-mindset?

- Deny your yesterday the right to decide your future.
- Do not be apologetic for your coat of many colours.
- Focus on a new hope with each new day.
- Believe you are a candidate of God's favour by asking Him boldly to show you favour.

PLACE VALUE ON GRACE

TEXT

Psalms 27:13-14 (NIV) "I remain confident in this: I will see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord."

BACKGROUND AND THOUGHTS ON THE TEXT: If you must achieve success in life, the grace-factor must never be absent in your pursuit as a Believer. Grace is that supernatural ability that gives you an edge over the natural. When the natural says you cannot have it, grace empowers you to have it. When the natural says that you're unqualified, grace declares you qualified!

Grace is a lifter of destinies but grace will lie dormant until you stir it up. Until you place value on grace, grace will never place value on you. How do you stir up grace? Discard the failure and limitation mentality, believe without any iota of doubt that you are God's candidate of God's blessings, declare God's promises over your life boldly, be a committed worshipper, pray in the Spirit at all times, and never make an important decision without the leading of the Holy Spirit.

You are the Lord of my life and I believe with my heart that you rose from the dead. I am saved! Thank you Father for saving me in the name of Jesus. Amen.

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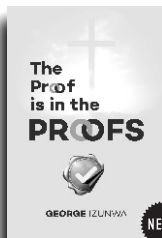
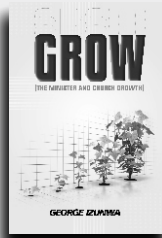
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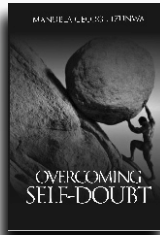
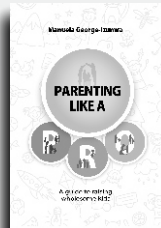
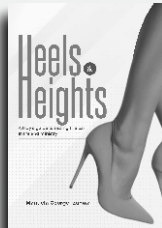
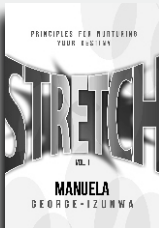
